Wis. Stats. 174.05 requires the owner of a dog more than five (5) months of age on January 1, of any year, or five (5) months of age within a license year to annually pay the dog license tax and obtain a license. Licenses are issued when the Municipal Clerk receives verification of rabies vaccination. Rabies vaccination is important to promote health, safety and general welfare of animals and the people around them. Late Fee of \$5.00 per animal will be assessed after March 31st.

Village Ordinance 7-1-18(c)(1) states "**No family shall own, harbor, or keep in its possession more than two (2) dogs** on any residentially zoned lot without the prior approval of the Village Board except that a litter of pups or a portion of a litter may be kept for not more than eight (8) weeks from birth...

Village Ordinance 93-3 states it shall be unlawful for any person in the Village of Cobb to own, harbor, or keep any cat more than five (5) months of age without complying with the provisions of the Ordinance relating to the listing, licensing, and tagging of the same. Same regulations apply for cats as dogs in the Village of Cobb.

Fines for unlicensed animals will be enforced by the lowa County Humane Officer and the lowa County Sheriff's Department.
